The Sunsail 44i is a high-performance cruising yacht built for comfort and designed for those looking for a fun week of sailing, in keeping with Sunsail's strategy to offer comfortable blue-water yachts that combine excellent equipment and great performance. Jeanneau's Prisma Process injection molding results in a 90% reduction in harmful emissions. The injection molded deck is over 700 lbs lighter than a traditionally molded deck of the same size, providing better stability and sea keeping.

The large cockpit features a spacious dining area while twin steering allows for optimal comfort at the helm and easy access to the aft transom for swimming, snorkeling and watersports. Conveniently located winches make sail handling by one or two people easy and leave guests undisturbed during maneuvers. A powerful bow thruster offers the ultimate in maneuverability.

Numerous opening hatches, ports and long salon windows allow for light and ventilation all the way through the yacht's interior, which features a contemporary design in a "fine teak" finish. The saloon provides stylish seating around a large table that converts to a double berth. Storage is plentiful in the fully equipped galley, while the cabins feature premium mattresses, and excellent ventilation, for maximum comfort aboard.

The new Sunsail 44i is available in a 3 cabin 3 head layout, or a 4 cabin 2 head version with additional convertible forward bunks, ideal for crew or kids, and can be booked now for charter this winter throughout the Caribbean: in Tortola – British Virgin Islands, St Martin, Guadeloupe, Martinique and St Vincent and the Grenadines, and next summer in Sunsail's Mediterranean bases in Turkey, Croatia and Greece.
